C221/25 **Apologies for Absence**

C220/25 To review and agree size and location of Petanque Terrain club house

RESOLVED: To approve a 7x3.5m timber club house on a thin concrete base on site A which is considered the best option to permit direct access to a gentle sloping path and provides an added safety barrier for spectators. HPC require this to be in the light brown colour as named on the illustration and request low level security lighting with an extension of the bund to align with the back of the club house and with the addition of soft landscaping around the club house.

C221/25 To consider patio extension at Mill Lane at a cost of £8,750

RESOLVED: To extend the patio by 14 slabs wide x 5 rows deep with 600mm slabs.

The remainder of the area will be either seeded or turfed and is to be decided at a future meeting of the Council.

C222/25 To consider extra footpath to be linked up with new accessible path to Petanque at a cost of £3,475
