P010/27. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE
No apologies were received.

P011/27. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

P016/27. PLANNING APPLICATIONS
It was **RESOLVED** that the following comments on the planning applications received from the Head of Planning and Development Services, EHDC, be passed to EHDC:
a) EHDC-25-0130-FUL – Mr T Locke – Land west of Lynton Dene, Liphook Road, Headley - Change of use of land from equestrian to a mixed use for the storage and distribution of timber, agricultural and equestrian (amended description and amended site plan received 5/12/25) – Although the Noise Impact report addresses some of our concerns,

we continue to **OBJECT** to this application. We still consider that the level and type of traffic movements along this narrow track with access onto Liphook Road will compromise the safety of other people using the track and the adjacent footpath. If the noise issue is acceptable to Environmental Health and the District Council is mindful to give permission, suitable noise abatement conditions should be imposed, including the “purpose built acoustic canopy” as recommended by the consultant

- b) EHDC-26-0258-HSE - Mr N Hobbs – 32 The Paddock, Headley, GU35 8QU – Erection of 1.8m/6ft high close-boarded fence to front boundary of property – **NO OBJECTION**
